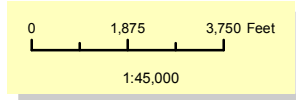

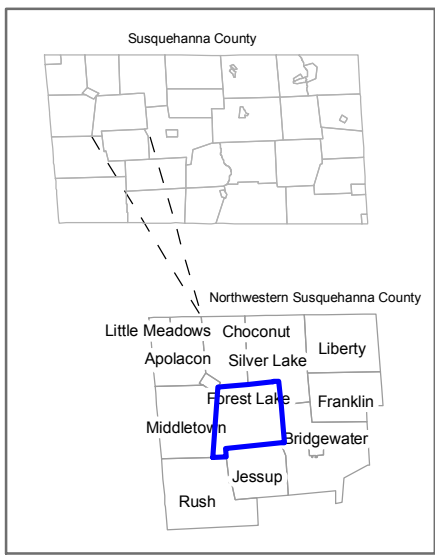
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ZONING DISTRICT BOUNDARIES

Zoning district boundary lines are intended to follow or be parallel to the center line of streets, streams, and railroads, and lot or property lines as they exist on a recorded deed or plan of record in the Susquehanna County Recorder of Deed's Office and on the Susquehanna County Tax Maps at the time of the enactment of the Zoning Map. Where district boundary lines are delineated by dimensions the boundary shall be parallel to the adjoining road at the specified horizontal dimension measured perpendicularly from the centerline of the road. In cases where a stream, pond or lake is surrounded by a zoning district such stream, pond or lake shall be considered a part of the zoning district.
